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MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTSMURRAY STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AND TEACHERS COLLEGE

JULY 13, 1927

The Board of Regents of the Murray State Normal School and Teachers College met in the office of the President on July 13, 1927 with the following members present: Mr. J. F. Wilson, Mr. T. H. Stokes and Mr. G. P. Thomas.

Contract for Concrete Walks and Retaining Walls

Moved by Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Wilson, that the contract as prepared and submitted for the construction of the concrete walks on the campus and retaining walls around the tennis courts, be approved and the President and Secretary of this Board be authorized to sign said contract on behalf of the Board of Regents. The roll was called upon the adoption of this motion with the following result: Thomas, aye; Wilson, aye; Stokes, aye.

Contract for Electrical Current and Lights

Moved by Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Wilson, that the contract submitted by the Kentucky-Tennessee Light and Power Company for the electric current and water used by this institution, be approved and the President and Secretary of this Board be authorized to sign said contract on behalf of the Board of Regents. The roll was called upon the adoption of this motion with the following result: Thomas, aye; Wilson, aye; Stokes, aye.

Finishing of Panels in Ceiling of Auditorium Building

Mr. Stokes and President Wells reported as a committee that they had secured bids for the finishing of the panels in the ceiling of the Auditorium Building.

After consideration by the Board of Regents, motion was made by Mr. Thomas and seconded by Mr. Wilson that an additional allowance of \$326.90 be granted to the contractor for the finishing of the panels in the ceiling of the Auditorium in sand finish to harmonize with the walls. Note: Mr. G. Tandy Smith, Jr., Architect, urgently insisted that the Board give the ceiling acoustical treatment rather than finish with top coat of plaster.

Finish on the front of Balcony in Auditorium Building


