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MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTSMURRAY STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AND TEACHERS COLLEGE

August 18, 1927

The Board of Regents of the Murray State Normal School and Teachers College met in the office of the President, Thursday, August 18, 1927, with the following members present: Dr. McHenry Rhoads, Mr. J. F. Wilson, Mr. T. H. Stokes and Mr. G. P. Thomas.

The Board, after consideration, awarded the contract for seating the Auditorium to Heywood-Wakefield, Chicago, Illinois, at the price of \$4.34 per seat.

As 10:30 A. M. the Board opened the sealed bids for the installation of a Central Heating Plant. The following bids were received:

On motion of Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Stokes, the contract was awarded to the Fisher Heating Company. The roll was called upon the adoption of said motion with the following result: Rhoads, aye; Wilson, aye; Stokes, aye; Thomas, aye.

The committee, appointed to purchase the equipment for the stage in the Auditorium, reported that the contract had been awarded to the Oklahoma City Scenic Company, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the price of \$3,650.00. The committee, appointed to contract for the extension of the lighting system and the installation of the program clock system, reported that the contract had been entered into with the Kentucky-Tennessee Light and Power Company for the price of \$1,854.00.

On motion of Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Thomas, it was ordered that the above contracts be approved. The roll was called upon the adoption of this motion with the following result: Rhoads, aye; Wilson, aye; Stokes, aye; Thomas, aye.

On motion of Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Thomas, it was ordered that the metal backs in the baths be eliminated. Upon a roll call the members voted as follows: Dr. Rhoads, aye; Mr. Wilson, aye; Mr. Stokes, aye; Mr. Thomas, aye.

On motion of Mr. Stokes, seconded by Mr. Wilson, it was ordered that the Physical Directors' rooms in the Auditorium Building and the walls above the tile brick in the baths be plastered. Upon roll call on the adoption of said motion the members voted as follows: Rhoads, aye; Wilson, aye; Stokes, aye; Thomas, aye.

On motion of Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Stokes, Mr. G. Tandy Smith, architect, was directed to advise the J. T. Jackson Lumber Company of the changes in the wood work in the Auditorium, and that the additional cost for making said change must be within a reasonable sum, not to exceed \$_____ and upon his failure to immediately furnish said wood work that the same be purchased elsewhere. Upon roll call on the adoption of said motion the members voted as follows: Dr. Rhoads, aye; Mr. Wilson, aye; Mr. Stokes, aye; Mr. Thomas, aye.

On motion by Mr. Stokes, seconded by Mr. Thomas, Mr. Wilson, Key-Langston Construction Company and Mr. Smith, Architect, were appointed as a committee to contract for the hardware for the Training School and Auditorium Buildings and select a design therefor. Upon roll call of the members on the adoption of said motion the votes stood as follows: Dr. Rhoads, aye; Mr. Stokes, aye; Mr. Thomas, aye.

It was ordered by the Board that the alternate for the underground installation of the Central Heating Plant of the Standard Underground Conduit Company be accepted in lieu of the installation of the Johns-Manville Company specified in the specifications.
