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MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTSMURRAY STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AND TEACHERS COLLEGE

December 29, 1927

The Board of Regents of the Murray State Normal School and Teachers College met in the office of the President on Thursday, December 29, 1927, as per adjournment of previous meeting, with the following members present: Mrs. Laurine Wells Lovett, Mr. J. F. Wilson, Mr. T. H. Stokes and Dr. McHenry Rhoads.

Reading of the Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of December 15, 1927 were read and ordered approved and signed as read.

Budget for Next Two Years

The amount of the claim to be filed with the Budget Commission, for new buildings and permanent improvements for the next two years, was discussed.

Moved by Mr. Stokes, seconded by Mr. Wilson, that we request \$250,000.00 from the Budget Commission, \$150,000.00 to be used for the construction and equipment of a Boys' Dormitory and \$100,000.00 for general improvements. The roll call upon the adoption of this motion resulted as follows: Mr. Wilson, aye; Mrs. Lovett, aye; Mr. Stokes, aye; Dr. Rhoads, aye.

Insurance on Training School, Auditorium and Heating Plant

Moved by Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Stokes, that \$80,000.00 worth each of fire and tornado insurance be taken out on the Training School Building, the same amount on the new Auditorium Building, \$5,000.00 on the Heating Plant, \$5,000.00 on the equipment in the Training School Building and \$3,000.00 on the equipment in the Auditorium Building. The roll call upon the adoption of this motion resulted as follows: Mrs. Lovett, aye; Mr. Wilson, aye; Mr. Stokes, aye; Dr. Rhoads, aye.

Draping of Windows in Auditorium

Moved by Mr. Stokes, seconded by Mr. Wilson, that the President be authorized to drape the windows in the new Auditorium Building. This motion was unanimously carried.

Purchase of Piano for New Auditorium

Moved by Mr. Stokes, seconded by Mr. Wilson, that the President be authorized to purchase a piano for the new Auditorium Building. This motion was unanimously carried.

Payment on Harris-Beyer Contract



Payment on Key-Langston Contract


