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MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTSMURRAY STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AND TEACHERS COLLEGE

May 30, 1929

The Board of Regents of the Murray State Normal School and Teachers College met in the office of the President for a short session on Commencement Day, Thursday, May 30, 1929, with the following members present: Mr. G. P. Thomas, Mrs. William H. Mason and Mr. G. P. Ordway.

Election of Additional Faculty

President Wells recommended the election of the following persons as members of the faculty for the periods of time and at the salaries stated:

Miss Virgie L. Nanney for the period beginning June 1, 1929 and ending September 15, 1929 at the rate of \$2,600.00 per calendar year

Mr. Eldon M. Aldred for the period beginning June 1, 1929 and ending September 15, 1929, at the rate of \$2,800.00 per calendar year

Miss Mary L. Gabbert as teacher in the training school for the period beginning September 15, 1929 and ending May 31, 1930, at the rate of \$2,400.00 per calendar year

Miss Mattie S. Trousdale as teacher in the training school for the period beginning September 15, 1929 and ending May 31, 1930, at the rate of \$2,400.00 per calendar year




