MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS
MURRAY STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AND TEACHERS COLLEGE

July 16, 1929

The Board of Regents of the Murray State Normal School and Teachers College met in the office of the President, Tuesday, July 16, 1929, with the following members present: Mr. J. F. Wilson, Mr. G. P.
