MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF REGENTSMURRAY STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AND TEACHERS COLLEGE

October 29, 1929

The Board of Regents of the Murray State Normal School and Teachers College met in the lobby of the Irvin Cobb Hotel at Paducah, Kentucky, at 3:15 P. M. Tuesday, October 29, 1929, with the following members present: Mr. J. F. Wilson, Mrs. William H. Mason and Mr. G. P. Ordway.

Election of Temporary Vice Chairman

In the absence of the Chairman and Vice Chairman, on motion of Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mrs. Mason, Mr. Ordway was elected Chairman pro tem.

Report of the Committee on Entrance, Credits, Certification and Graduation

In the absence of President Wells, Dean Carr presented the report of the Committee on Entrance, Credits, Certification and Graduation and recommended that it be accepted and the certificates issued and renewed in accordance with the following recommendations:
