The Board of Regents of the Murray State Teachers College met in special session in the office of the President at 2:00 p. m. on Monday, May 26, 1947, as per the call of the Chairman. The following members were present: Mr. Winslow and Mr. Price. There was no quorum present.

Bids Received and Opened for Installation of Air Conditioning System in Fine Arts Building


Bids for Installation of Air Conditioning System in the Fine Arts Building were received and opened as per schedule. Two bids were received as follows:


1. Bid from York Corporation, 119 South 11th Street, St. Louis 2, Missouri, signed by Mr. R. O. Bair, District Treasurer, in the amount of \$19,750.00. Certified check of \$988.00 accompanied bid. Representative of York Corporation, Mr. Harry W. Walling, 1137 Sterick Building, Memphis, Tennessee, was present at the opening of bids.
2. Bid from Ed D. Hannan, 317-319 Kentucky Avenue, Paducah, Kentucky, signed by Mr. Emmett D. Hannan, Owner and doing business as Ed D. Hannan, in the amount of \$24,995.00. Bid Bond in the amount of \$1250.00, #2156682, with Fidelity and Casulty Company of New York accompanied bid. Representative present at opening of bids, Mr. Emmett D. Hannan, Paducah, Kentucky.

Due to the fact that a quorum of the Board of Regents was not present, no action was taken in regard to the bids received.

Mr. Alfred S. Joseph, Jr., of Joseph & Joseph, Architects, Louisville, and Mr. R. W. Clinton, Engineer, Louisville, were present at the opening of the bids.
