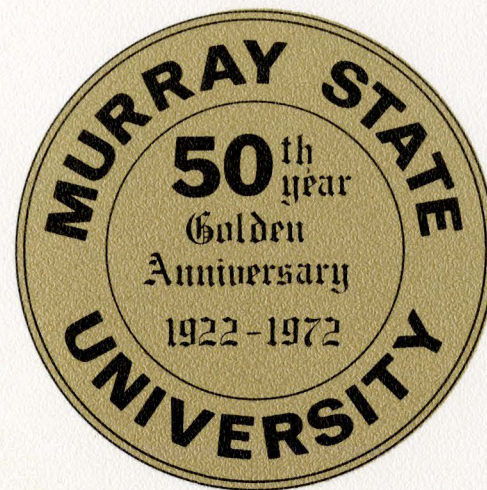




Dear Parents and Honored Guests,
