
On behalf of the Student Body, I take this opportunity to welcome each of you to Murray State University's Annual Honors Day Program.

We are very pleased to have you here. We hope that your visit is pleasant and that you will return soon to share in our hopes and dreams as we pursue our education at Murray State University.

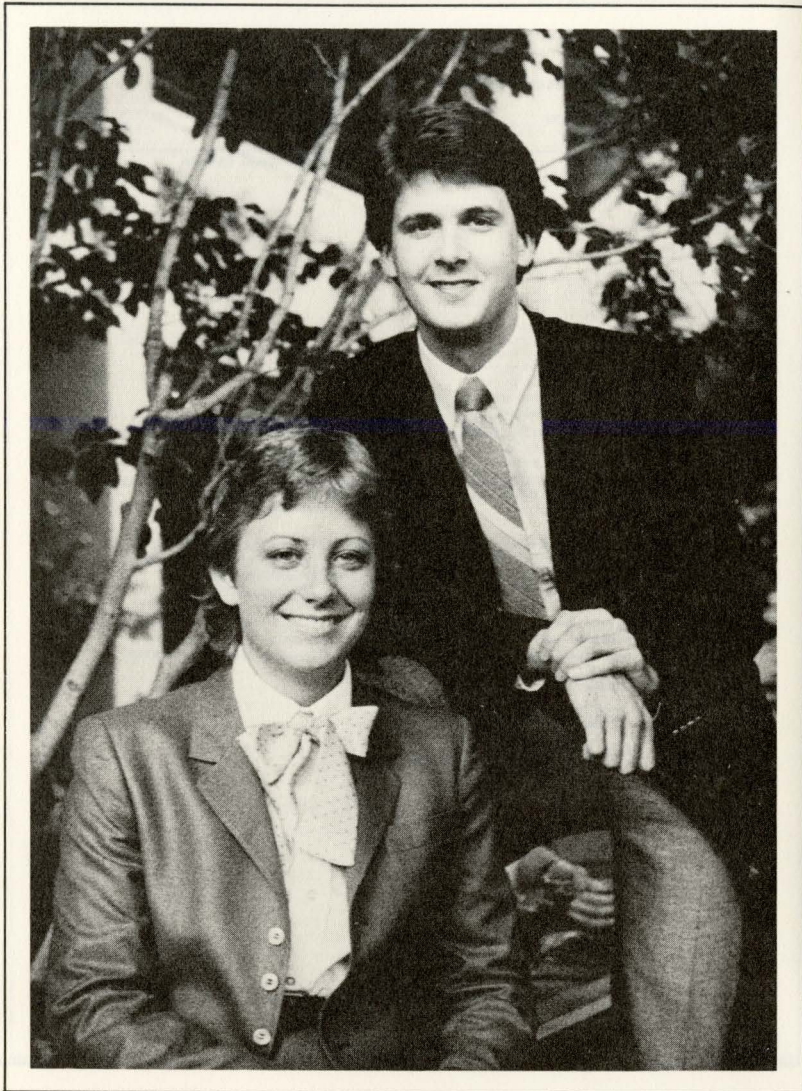
