How Property is Listed Under the New Law.

The law provides that the Assessor shall list the value of property. The law differs from that of the old law in that the owner of the property is sworn to fix a true valuation on his property as well as to give a true list. The following is the form of the oath:

"We do swear that the list of taxable property about to be given in by you will contain a full and complete list and the best description you can give, of all and every species of property belonging to you or in your possession subject to taxation on the 15th day of September last, and that according to your best judgment, you will value your property at its fair cash value, and that no removal of property or omission has been made, or any method or device adopted or practiced whereby to evade the payment of taxes by you and that you will make true and perfect answers to such questions concerning your taxable property, or that of others in your possession, or about to be listed by you for taxation."

The law provides that if any one shall willfully make a false statement or report of value whatever for the purpose of avoiding or lessening the tax he shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$100, and be liable to the payment of three times the amount of taxes on his estate.

Methodist Appointments.

The meeting of the Methodist Conference at Russellville last week was one of the most glorious gatherings ever had in the denomination. The town was filled to overflowing by visitors and the city became a great fair.

The meetings of the Conference were very interesting. Bishop Hendricks presiding with much ability. Among the appointments made were the following: Rev. E. W. Watson, who has served his people here so faithfully, goes to Henderson. Rev. J. W. Lewis takes his place. Mr. Lewis was pastor here eight years ago and is much loved by our people. We are glad to welcome him back. Rev. J. W. Bigham still remains on the Fairview circuit, and Rev. E. H. Hayes remains presiding Elder of this district. Dr. B. C. Catlett goes to Cairo and Rev. J. W. Emmerston to Ekron. Rev. T. L. Cranford was appointed to the Crofton mission. Rev. S. B. Bowles goes to Trenton and Rev. E. E. Fale to Lafayette.

The meeting of the conference will be held at Hartford.

Tobacco Barns Burned.
