**Making Sea Weed Useful.**  
An English chemist has found a way for turning to account the practically limitless quantity of sea weed that is the ocean supplies, or at least as much of it as may be desired. He boils the weed with carbonate of soda and treats the filtered solution with sulphuric acid, obtaining from it in this manner a substance that has more viscosity than starch, or even gum arabic, and that can be profitably employed in stiffening various textile fabrics. It is also said to be excellently adapted for the making of syrups, and for certain culinary uses. From the residue left after the extraction of this material, a very good quality of writing paper can be cheaply made.
