## 845 Are X-rayed For TB

Eight hundred and forty-five Marshall County residents were x-rayed here Tuesday and Wednesday for tuberculosis.

The x-rays were made in the mobile unit of the State Health Department. The big van was parked in front of the city hall.

On the first day, 368 persons were x-rayed. On the second day there were 487.

All high school students of the county took advantage of the opportunity and were examined for any signs of tuberculosis.

The mobile unit was in Benton only two days this trip. Usually it is here an entire week.

The unit went from Benton to Smithland.

## BURLEY VOTING PLACES ARE ANNOUNCED

Polling places for the burley tobacco referendum to be held Saturday, Nov. 22, were announced this week by Everett Treas, county PMA chairman.

Voting places are: District 1, Aurora school; District 2, Briensburg school; District 3, Palma school; District 4, Oak Level school, and District 5, Brewers school.

Polls will open at 9 a. m. and close at 5 p. m.

The election is being held to determine if marketing quotas will continue in effect. If quotas are approved by burley growers, farm acreage allotments will be continued at a level designed to keep production in proper balance with demand.

There will be acreage allotments in 1953 only if quotas are approved.
