

Churches to offer community meals through holidays


St. John Missionary Baptist Church and Northside Baptist Church have come together to assist those who may be in need of some holiday cheer this year. The churches will be offering four meals free of charge.

The meals will be held at St. John Missionary Baptist Church at 122 Spruce Street on four separate Saturdays. The idea behind the offering, supporters say, is to supply the necessary food and nourishment for the bodies and souls of men, women and children facing hunger without regard to race, color, religion, gender, age, national origin or physical or mental disabilites - and that is a beautiful thing not easily found in the world.

"It's about feeding the needy and hungry," Sister Clara Bushrod said. "Anyone who wants to come is welcome to come. We're here to help, and it doesn't matter who it is. It's all about helping people."

Bushrod is assisting in the coordination of the meals, called "Food for the Soul" and "Bread of Life" Community Fellowship. According to information supplied by Bushrod, the hope is to supply a Christian response to the world in the form of a living ministry.

Cope said last year's inaugural event raised \$17,000 for Playhouse, which was more than the \$10,000. Since \$7,500 of that came from matching donations that are not available this year, she said she didn't know if they could raise the same amount, but she is hoping to still do very well. "It was hugely successful," Cope said: "Of course, the money was teriffic, but everybody who came just talked about what a great time they had, how much fun it was, and we felt the same way. I told my board that if we hadn't raised a single dollar, we still had a really good time. So we knew right away that we wanted to do it again."

Cope said she was hoping to eventually remodel the bathrooms at the Playhouse, and that the money raised would also go toward helping pay for recent light and sound board repairs, as well as some of the damage from when the pipes in her office burst and flooded the room last July.

Dog retires after serving 9 years in military

FORT KNOX, Ky. (AP) — A ceremony at Fort Knox has honored the work of a special solider as she was retired from service.

WDRB-TV reports that 10year-old Mandy, a Belgian Malinois, was honored at the central Kentucky post during a ceremony for her years of service, which included tours in Afghanistan and Iraq. During the ceremony, Mandy was awarded the Army Commendation Medal for her service.

Capt. Joel Maxwell says Mandy has completed a total of over 80 missions, including presidential protection details. She was retired for medical reasons.

In combat zones, military dogs have a very important job. "They detect explosives and are able to find the IED's and find them before they are detonated on our soldiers," Maxwell said.

Chandler ponders future after losing election

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — U.S. Rep. Ben Chandler says he's not sure what the future holds for him after he leaves elected office in January.

Chandler told the Lexington Herald-Leader and The Courier-Journal that he hasn't made up his mind about what he'll do, but he has several options. Some of those include a possible appointment to a government position, lobbying or practicing law.

Chandler also didn't rule out another run for public office in the future. But right now, he says he's looking forward to spending some time with his family at home in central Kentucky. Chandler has served as a congressman since 1994, but held state offices before that.

He is the grandson of A.B. "Happy" Chandler, a former governor and U.S. senator.

"I have no idea what the future holds," he said Thursday morning after losing his seat to Republican Andy Barr. "Right now, two days after the election, I'm not interested in doing anything," he said with a laugh. "But I don't rule anything entirely out."

He noted that the 6th District is a conservative one — he won re-election over Barr in 2010 by a mere 648 votes.

"To have held it for nine years is a pretty good piece of work," he said. "As soon as President (Barack) Obama was elected in 2008, it was clear that I was on the target list for Republicans. They immediately pumped millions of dollars in here to try to defeat me.

"And two years ago, I was able to pull it out. They did everything they could this year to tie me with the president, who is unpopular in Kentucky.

with six different villages. They met with some of the adults in the program who were traveling to different countries and spent a month in Tanzania.

The main challenge was to live off the local food and water. The water had to be boiled and there were outbreaks of malaria. The food was from local produce and the Americans had to adapt to the condition. Masterson said that several in her group got sick until they got used to the food.

One of her worst days was the last day when they left by bus for a 32-hour ride to their airport. The bus would stop every five hours and she became very sick. Part of the problem was that the African public bus smelled bad and kept her sick. But, she made it through.

The other bad day was when a camera was stolen from one of the girls in the mission group. The locals lined up very young girls who had been with the mission girls and asked each one if she had stolen the camera. No matter what the answer or if there was no answer, each little girl was smacked. Masterson said she was able to stop it before all of the little girls were hit.

Masterson said that she found out about the mission trip from a friend. After she was accepted, she said she raised about \$4,000 for the trip. Some of the money came from the First Baptist Church in Maryville, III., and from the Hardin Baptist Church in Marshall County. She also

Man robs U.S. Bank in Paducah; witnesses say no weapon produced

PADUCAH, KY - A man who claimed to be armed robbed U.S. Bank on James Sanders Boulevard Friday in Paducah.

West Kentucky Star reported that the man fled the bank shortly after 3 p.m., heading toward the area of the Gander Mountain sporting goods store across from the east end of Kentucky Oaks Mall on foot. He claimed to be armed but witnesses say he did not produce a weapon.

Members of the Paducah Police Department's new Traffic Enforcement Unit and other patrol officers were in the mall area when the call was dispatched, and were on the scene within minutes. Officer Nathan Antonites and his K9 partner, Junior, tracked the

Teen pleads guilty in newborn's death

PADUCAH, Ky. (AP) — A western Kentucky teen has pleaded guilty to a manslaughter charge in the death of her newborn.

The Paducah Sun reports 18-year-old Katelynn Teague entered the plea on Thursday to the reduced charge. Originally, she had faced a murder charge in the death of the infant girl, whose body was found last November in a closet of Teague's home in Paducah.

Police say an investigation found that Teague gave birth to the child earlier that night.

She originally told detectives that the child was born alive, but then stopped breathing and she panicked. Later, she said the child was stillborn. Medical reports found that the infant died of suffocation and neglect.

Teague's sentencing was set for Dec. 11.

TECO laying off 90 in coalfields

HAZARD, Ky. (AP) — About 90 jobs are being lost in the eastern Kentucky coalfields.

WYMT-TV in Hazard reported TECO Coal Corporation is cutting back production and shedding jobs.

Company personnel director Paul Matney told the station no mines are closing, but manpower and staffing is being trimmed to match reduced production from the mines.

Matney said the layoffs are at several locations and are the result of economic conditions in the coal market.

'Dancing' champion returns to Fort Campbell

FORT CAMPBELL, Ky. (AP) — Actor and inspirational speaker J.R. Martinez, who won Season 13 of "Dancing With The Stars," returns to Fort Campbell, Ky., where he once served in the 101st Airborne Division.

Martinez will be at the post on the Tennessee-Kentucky state line Friday to sign copies of his new book, "Full of Heart," his personal story of survival and recovery after being injured in Iraq.

Martinez, who was an actor on the daytime soap opera "All My Children," suffered burns over 30 percent of his body after he was trapped in a vehicle struck by an improvised explosive device in 2003.

Independent to run for Senate presidency

FRANKFORT, Ky. (AP) — An independent from Paducah says he's running for the top position in the Republican-controlled state Senate.

The Courier-Journal and the Lexington Herald Leader reported state Sen. Bob Leeper made the announcement Thursday.

It says half of the 60 positions have already been filled and are operating at an interim site in Shepherdsville. The other jobs will be filled over the next 12 months.



Military hero Petraeus admits to affair, resigns from CIA

WASHINGTON (AP) — David Petraeus, the retired four-star general renowned for taking charge of the military campaigns in Iraq and then Afghanistan, abruptly resigned Friday as director of the CIA, admitting to an extramarital affair.

The affair was discovered during an FBI investigation, according to officials briefed on the developments. Petraeus carried on the affair with his biographer and reserve Army officer Paula Broadwell, according to several U.S. officials with knowledge of the situation.

The FBI discovered the relationship by monitoring Petraeus' emails, after being alerted Broadwell may have had access to his personal email account, two of the officials said. Broadwell did not respond to voice mail or email messages seeking comment.

Petraeus' resignation shocked Washington's intelligence and political communities. It was a sudden end to the public career of the best-known general of the post 9/11 wars, a man sometimes mentioned as a potential Republican presidential candidate.Petraeus, who turned 60 Wednesday, told CIA employees in a statement that he had met with President Barack Obama at the White House on Thursday and asked to be allowed to resign. On Friday, the president accepted.

Jury being selected in torture-slaying retrial

JACKSON, Tenn. (AP) — Jury selection has begun in Jackson for the retrial of one of the defendants in the torture-slayings of a young Knoxville couple.

According to The Jackson Sun, the trial of Vanessa Coleman of Lebanon, Ky., is scheduled to start in Knoxville on Tuesday. Authorities say jurors are being selected from a pool in Madison County because of the publicity the case has received in East Tennessee.

Coleman is being retried in the January 2007 killing of Channon Christian. Coleman does not face charges in the killing of Christian's boyfriend, Christopher Newsom.

Coleman and three men were earlier convicted in separate trials, but the judge that presided has resigned and been disbarred because of pill abuse while he was on the bench.

if you stood still the slight area but I still hear the wind even today.



There will be many hunters afield for opening weekend so safety is of utmost importance. Regardless of where you are hunting, always assume that other hunters could be in the area. Remember that all hunters are required to wear hunter orange vests or jackets and hunter orange caps while in the field.

The opening of the Modern Gun Season is timed to coincide with the peak of the rut in Kentucky and by all indications the rut is in full swing. record the harvest data on

The "rut" by the way is the whitetail deer's mating season. Bucks that are typically very secretive and nocturnal are now running wild over the landscape looking for amorous does.

That's why my best advice for hunting during the rut is to remain on the stand all day. Bucks expand their territories this time of year and will actively roam day and night to check out the does and to freshen scrapes (scrapes are places where the deer paw away grass and leaves, then urinate in the loose soil as a means of leaving a calling card). Most of the big deer l have taken have shown up between 11:00 am and 2:00

When you take a deer,

your deer tag or harvest log before removing the deer from the field. Yes, that means it is necessary to carry a ball-point pen along with you while deer hunting. Once a deer is harvested, the animal must be checked through the handydandy, automated Telecheck system by midnight on the day the animal is recovered. The toll-free number for Telecheck is 1-800-245-4263.

Harvested deer must be checked through Telecheck before they can be left at a processor. The processor will prepare a carcass tag for the deer which must include the Telecheck conformation number. If you give your deer to another person, a carcass tag must be attached to the animal that includes the hunter's name, phone number, and

Telecheck conformation number. No deer may be transported out of Kentucky without first being registered through Telecheck.

Deer season is not the only season opening up right away. Quail and rabbit season opens on Nov. 12 in the western hunting zone. Bird and bunny hunters must use extreme caution while hunting during the deer season and must comply with all hunter orange regulations

Wild turkeys may be taken by bow or crossbow during the deer season, but cannot be taken with a shotgun. Of course, it is illegal to shoot a turkey with a rifle. The shotgun season for wild turkey will resume Dec. 1-7. Bobcat season does not begin until noon on Nov. 24.

Waterfowl season will open in Kentucky on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 22. Squirrel season will reopen Nov. 12. Coyotes and wild pigs are legal game year-round. The season for crows has ended but will resume on Jan. 4.

There are a lot of seasons in motion during the month of November - many of which overlap. Please consult the Kentucky Hunting and Trapping Guide (available online or where ever hunting licenses are sold) for detailed information. Above all, make safety the first priority and be courteous to fellow hunters

Properly dispose of your kill

FRANKFORT, Ky. Thousands of Kentlicky hunters will hit the woods this Saturday, Nov. 10, the opening day of modern gun deer season.

"It is a great way to get free range, organic natural meat," said Tina Brunjes, big game coordinator for the Kentucky D partment of Fish and Vildlife Resources. "You can iso feed your family with process the deer yourself, you'll have legs, hide, bones and other leftovers to discard.

Where do you put these remains? This question is one of the overlooked challenges of successful deer hunting.

"Ideally, you would leave the guts in the field or bury them onsite with landowner permission," explained. "The guts will be one in a day or two. All of · your scavengers, crows, vultures, raccoons and even redtailed hawks will consume them. Ask the landowner if you can dispose of the leg bones, fur, hide and other leftovers from processing. Don't leave them where people can see or smell them."

"Legally, you cannot dump the carcass along the side of a roadway, near a boat ramp, in a creek or on a wildlife management area," said Maj. Shane Carrier, assistant director of law enforcement for Kentucky Brunjes Fish and Wildlife. "This is criminal littering and you can be cited for it. Sometimes, peo-

the garbage," Brunjes said. "Many allow you to do this. Check with your local landfill and see if you can dispose of it there.'

You can also pay a deer processor to do this for you, but you will still need to dispose of the guts.

"Hunters must remember they must telecheck their deer before processing," Carrier said. "People think filling out their harvest log is enough, but they must telecheck their deer before removing the head or hide or dropping it off at the processor."





If you live in a suburban area and need to dispose of your deer carcass, you do have options. "Contact your local municipality and see if you can bag it and dispose of it through

Hunters who want to learn how to process their own deer may order "Kentucky Afield" television's excellent deer processing video. This video shows step-by-step the easy way to field dress, skin and debone your deer and make the proper cuts for delicious roasts and steaks. You may purchase one by visiting Kentucky Fish and Wildlife's website at fw.ky.gov and click on the "Kentucky Afield Store" logo.

Brunjes also reminds deer hunters to show consideration to the landowner who was kind enough to allow you to hunt.

"Be respectful of their neighboring landowner," she said. "You don't have a right to retrieve a deer from someone else's property without permission, something to keep in mind if you hunt close to the property boundary. Don't discharge your weapon near someone's home, outbuildings or near livestock. Always leave gates as you found them, open or closed."

Modern gun deer season opens Nov. 10 and closes Nov. 19 in Zones 3 and 4 and closes Nov. 25 in Zones 1 and 2. For more information on deer hunting regulations, pick up a copy of the current Kentucky Hunting and Trapping Guide available wherever hunting licenses are sold. You may request a free copy by calling 1-800-858-1549 or view a printable version on the Kentucky Fish and Wildlife website at fw.ky.gov.



National WW2 Museum exhibit to examine POWs held by Nazis

EW ORLEANS (AP) - A violin made from bed slats, a bomber jacket, and journals filled with humor, nostalgia, sorrow and boredom help to tell the stories of the 92,820 Allied soldiers held in nearly 100 Nazi prisoner of war camps

"Guests of the Third Reich," an exhibit opening on Veterans Day at the National World War II Museum is about those "Kriegies," as they called themselves - short for "Kriegsgefangener," German for "prisoner of war."

Items on display through July 7 are among those to be shown in the Liberation Pavilion planned for completion in 2016. That pavilion will also have a section about POWs held in brutal Japanese POW camps where more than 40 percent of the 27,465 Americans captured in the Pacific died. But of 93,941 who surrendered to Germany, 92,820 survived.

Japan had not ratified the Geneva Conventions for humane treatment of POWs. Germany had, and generally followed its requirements.

Not always. One part of the exhibit is about POWs who were sent to concentration camps or executed. Those in the concentration camps included 350 Americans sent from Stalag IXB to

the slave labor camp in Berga because they were or "looked" Jewish, and 168 Allied airmen sent to nearby Buchenwald. Another 362 American POWS and more than 100 Belgians were killed in groups, including 84 shot in the "Malmedy Massacre," a mass killing first reported by Associated Press war correspondent Hal Boyle.

The exhibit is divided in five sections: Capture, Camp Life, Liberation, Global Conflict - which includes the "War Crimes" area - and After the Camps

Camp Life includes seven "wartime logs" diaries provided by the YMCA to be sent in Red Cross packages for POWs. Their contents have been scanned and put on iPads so visitors can page through them.

"There's probably about 700 pages in all if you read all of them," said curator Kimberly Guise. Some of the diaries' contents also are on the website set up for the exhibit.

Early American POWs were airmen, who hit the ground at a rate of about 400 a month in 1943. Then came the Battle of the Bulge, when nearly 23,000 Americans, most of them infantry, were captured in December 1944.

Most of the logs include drawings of burning aircraft or memorials to dead crewmen, Guise said.

The men also described lighter moments.

"There are a number of ways we spend our spare time. As I sit here writing this, there are two across from me studying French, some are playing cards, others are reading books, the rest have the two guitars, anything to keep your mind occupied and not think of home," wrote Bruce L. Worrell, captured in Italy in May 1994 during service with the 85th Infantry Division's 359th Infantry Regiment and held at Stalag IIB.

Guise said, "There were whole colleges that were set up. They called them barbed-wire universities."

The diaries, each printed with the title "A Wartime Log," also include home addresses of men in the camp, cartoons, drawings of other POWs - sometimes with comments by other soldiers and airmen - maps, photographs from home, and lovingly detailed drawings of U.S. bombers and of pinup girls, sometimes together. There also are programs and even photographs of plays put on by POWs, collections of cigarettes and of military patches, and a lot of verse. There

are song parodies and also verses clipped from magazines and newspapers. Some may have been written by the POW; others are written from memory. Some were copied and recopied from log to log

Guise said she was struck by a parody of "Thanks for the Memories" that showed up in several logs.

"It sounds unbelievable - something that would be in 'Hogan's Heroes' or a comedy film," she said.

The flight jacket was worn by Paul Hayslip, the only crewman on the B-26 bomber "Ramblin' Wreck" who was able to parachute to safety before it crashed. A photograph shows him and his crew at Louisiana's Barksdale Field, now Barksdale Air Force Base

The violin's neck was whittled from a chair leg by Clair Cline, an Army Air Corps pilot captured in Holland and held in Stalag I after his B-24 was shot down in February 1944. He and others scraped glue from chairs to hold it together.

"It traveled the country in 1946 as part of an exhibition of POW life," Guice said. She said Cline's son, grandson and granddaughter, all professional string players, offered it while she was planning the exhibit. Cline himself was a carpenter after the war, she said.







For grapefruit lovers, the news isn't bad

that grapefruit can interact dangerously with some medications. Is this true?

DEAR READER: I love grapefruit and grapefruit juice, so I remember my reaction the day a colleague told me about new research showing such dangerous interactions: Bummer!

Grapefruit and grapefruit juice are a great source of vitamin C. potassium. dietary fiber and other nutrients. But there's another side to the **Dr. Komaroff** story. Grape-

can interact with dozens of medications -sometimes with dangerous results.

Doctors are not sure which of the chemicals in grapefruit are responsible for changing the way vour body handles certain drugs. The leading candidate is a chemical that binds to an enzyme (a type of protein) in your intestinal tract. This enzyme normally reduces the absorption of certain medicines. When grapefruit juice blocks the enzyme, it's easier for the medication to pass from your gut to your bloodstream. As a result, blood levels rise faster and higher than normal. In some cases, the abnormally high levels can be dangerous.

Grapefruit juice can boost the effect of many drugs to varying degrees. Unfortunately for us grapefruit lovers, those include some of the most widely prescribed drugs: calcium channel blockers, statins, benzodiazepines, neurological and psychiatric drugs, drugs for erectile dysfunction and immunosuppressants.

the effects of drugs that are bringing health benefits? Because if blood levels of beneficial drugs get too high, they can produce toxic effects. For example, high levels of benzodiazepines can make you fall asleep at the wheel. High levels of statins can cause muscle and liver damage.

Different brands of the same type of drug may be more or less affected by grapefruit. On my website, AskDoctorK.com, I've put a chart listing which brands of various types of drugs are more or less affected.

It doesn't take much grapefruit juice to boost the levels of affected drugs -- sometimes it takes only a single glass. What's more, the effect wears off slowly, and its impact is still evident after 24 hours.

To be on the safe side, ask your doctor if any of the medicines you take are affected by grapefruit. If the answer is yes: -- Switch to orange juice.

-- If you are really hooked on grapefruit juice, ask your doctor whether you can switch to a related (but less vulnerable) drug in a class, such as a different kind of statin.

-- Avoid taking your pills and your juice simultaneously. The more time between the two -and the smaller your glass of juice the better.

Finally, Seville (sour) oranges and tangelos may have the same effect on medications as grapefruit. Apply the guidelines for grapefruit to them as well.

You might wonder if my advice isn't too conservative. It may be Someday, more research may show that while there is an increased risk of dangerously high blood levels of certain drugs, the risk that a person will suffer serious consequences still is small. Until we know more, this grapefruit lover has reluctantly decided to make it an occasional guilty pleasure.






