Research Methodology

Photovoice is a participatory research “technique that allows individuals to photograph their everyday realities and highlight factors that may enhance or diminish their individual health status or that of the community” (Doyle, et. al, 2010).

To conduct my research, I traveled the most traffic-busy streets in Murray (Main Street and both North and South 12th Street), assuming these are general areas where multiple people in Murray go.

While on these roads, I was taking note of two things: the access to food that I recognized (primarily focusing on restaurants as opposed to grocery store due to convenience) as well as what opportunities these areas offered or encouraged physical activity.
