HOW WANAMAKER GOT THERE.

Republican organs always attempt to treat lightly the charge made by the Democrats that the present Postmaster General of the United States was put into the cabinet as a reward for his services in raising money for campaign purposes in 1888. But the truth of this charge is clearly established by the admissions of the very men who assisted Wanamaker to raise that famous \$400,000 just before the last Presidential election. The rich manufacturers of Philadelphia who contributed most of this great contribution fund for Boss Quay's use, are members of the Philadelphia Manufacturers Club, an organization of high protective tariff men. We make the assertion that the money contributed by this club last year had more influence upon the result of the national election than all the skill, the ingenuity, the labor and the pulling of all the professional politicians in Philadelphia. We believe this proposition to be capable of positive proof. If, therefore, control of patronage is rightly the reward of victorious effort, the right of this club to name the federal officials of Philadelphia rests upon solid ground."

The members of this plutocratic and monopolistic club accepted John Wanamaker's appointment as the reward for the large amount of fat which was fried out of them, and did not hesitate to publish the fact. And still Republicans will be found who boast that their party is "the party of high moral ideas."

President Harrison has selected one Dave Martin of Indiana, said to be one of the most corrupt and unprincipled specimens of him and briber ever seen in the United States, as chief adviser and dirty-working-ordinary to the Republican national campaign committee. Martin is on Quay's order, but far worse man than Quay, and will do anything—however sordidly—to accomplish his vile ends. Hackett, the Chairman of the New York State Republican Committee, is another corrupt politician of the secret circular kind, who is trying to purchase votes in advance. The New York World has this to say of them: "With Wm. McKinley talking lies to the people about their taxes, and the saintly Wanamaker raising corruption funds and prostituting the Postoffice Department to the use of law-breakers, it is no wonder that Martin and Hackett feel encouraged to brazen it out."

The declaration of Judge Walter G. Greenham, of Indiana, that he will vote for Grover Cleveland, has been followed by the announcement that Judge Thomas F. Conley, of Michigan, and Hon. Wayne McVeigh, of Pennsylvania, will likewise cast their votes for the Democratic ticket. Democracy. Judge Conley stands at the head of the legal procession in the West, and McVeigh was Attorney General of the United States under Mr. Garfield, and is an able, scholarly man. It is not remarkable that these upright, conscientious and patriotic men should have quit the Republican party and come over to the Democrats. What is remarkable is that so many other upright and fair-minded Republicans stick to their party under its present corrupt and dishonest management. VERY BLOODY WORK.

Eight Men Killed and Three Others Mortally Wounded.

Terrible Results of a Raid on a Bank by Robbers at Collierville, Tenn.

Kansas City, Oct. 6.—A special from Wichita, Kan., says: Eight men killed and three mortally wounded were the result of a raid made yesterday by the Dalton and Barker gangs on the banks of Collierville, Kan.

At about 10 o'clock a mob entered Collierville, Kan., overpowered the clerks and robbed the bank. Leaving a guard to prevent the alarm being given, four of the gang of robbers went to the First National Bank and demanded the money, but President Schurr and Cashier Ayers, who were behind the counter, refused to surrender the cash, and the robbers opened fire on them, and mortally wounded both. They then seized the plunder and started for their horses, which were hitched in an alley a block distant.

THE REGISTRATION.

Revised Figures Showing the Strength of the Two Parties in Hopkinsville.

The Democrats of Hopkinsville have no reason to feel despondent over the result of Tuesday's registration. The figures show a majority of less than one hundred votes in favor of the Republicans, while heretofore the majority in the city has been from one hundred and fifty to two hundred. In each of the four city precincts the Democrats turned out in force and record their names upon the registration books. Sixty Democrats in the city remained to be registered, and all of these with two exceptions are either sick or out of town. Assuming that they qualify themselves for the exercise of the franchise prior to November, which they are allowed to do, under the law, the Republican majority will be overcome by proper work and systematic organization. The Republicans have had less votes left; their strength has been registered. Scores of colored men, it is well known, have been sent to Indiana to assist the Republicans to carry that State for the national ticket.

The figures below show the actual number of votes registered.
