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CHRISTMAS SERMON.

REV. DR. TALMAGE ON THE BIRTH OF CHRIST.

More in Want—What the World Needs Most—The Nativity of the Offspring of Hope. Merry With the Thought of His Forgiveness.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 22.—In his sermon today Dr. Talmage shows the universal theme of the season—the Christmas. The text selected was, "Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem," Matthew 1:1.

At midnight from one of the galleries of the sky a chant broke. To an ordinary observer there would have been such a celestial demonstration. A poor man and wife—travelers, Joseph and Mary by name—had lodged in an out-house of an unimportant village. The supreme hour of solemnity had passed, and upon the pallid forehead and cheek of Mary, God had set the dignity, the grandeur, the tenderness, the overlying and divine significance of motherhood.

But such scenes had often occurred in Bethlehem, yet never before had a star been unfurled and had a host of light manifested over the hills and valleys. If there had been such brilliant and mighty recognition of an advent in the house of Pharaoh, or at the west end of the house of Caesar, or the house of Habsburg, or the house of Stuart, we would not so much have wondered; but a star seems too poor a comely for such delicate and angelic circumstance. The angels seem too small for so great an act, the music too grand for such unimportant auditors, the window of the stable too rude to be surrounded by other worlds.

A Humble Birth. It is my joy to tell you that what was that night in the village barn, and as I want to make my discourse cumulative and climacteric I begin in the first place by telling you that that night in the Bethlehem manger was born in our country the child who is to be our king. He had only two friends—his parents. No saint had been born, no delicate attention, but star and the cattle and the coarse jacks and banter of the camel drivers. No wonder the medieval patients represent the scene as kneeling before the infant Jesus, for there were no men there at that time to worship. From the depths of the manger he came until he is honored in all Christendom and sits on the imperial throne in heaven.

What name is mightiest today in Christendom? Jesus. Who has more friends on earth than any other being? Jesus. Before whom do the most devoted kneel in chapel and church and cathedral this hour? Jesus. From what depths of poverty to what heights of renown? And so let all those who are poor and sorrowful remember that they cannot be more poor than the child who was born in the manger. Let them look up to his example while they have time and eternity to imitate it.

Do you know that the vast majority of the world's deliverers had humble birthplaces? Luther, the emancipator of religion, born among the mines; Shakespeare, the emancipator of literature, born in a humble home at Stratford-on-Avon; Columbus, the discoverer of a world, born in poverty at Genoa; Hogarth, the discoverer of how to make art accurate and administrative of virtue, born in a humble home in Westminster; Kitchin and Pringle, whose names are on the map of the world, born in the manger. I have no time to tell you of the rest of the world's deliverers who were born in the manger. 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A DECISION RENDERED.

It's of Interest to All Tobacco Men.

The Court of Appeals has rendered a decision that will be interesting to every tobacco grower, buyer and seller in the State, as it involves their right to make a contract extending the time for re-planting or re-sowing tobacco to ten months in the United States and nine months in the foreign country.

The Kentucky statute prescribes 8 months in the United States and 6 months if shipped abroad. However, the inspectors and dealers at Nashville, where the crop originates, sought to extend this time to 9 and 9 months, as mentioned above, but the Court of Appeals, in passing on the question says:

"It is axiomatic that no custom can be established or maintained in opposition to an express statute; and that customs of trade may exist where they do not contravene an express statute; but when the legislature speaks their will in a statute, it is not necessary to wait the time of reference to such laws, but what can be learned of these private contracts between traders and sellers; the inspector, broker and purchaser? We deem any contract changing the law of the State in reference to these sales as in contravention of public policy and therefore non-enforceable."

Disembowled. Shelbyville, Ky., Dec. 22.—A terrible cutting affair occurred last night at Jacksonville, a remote settlement in the extreme northeast of this county. A man named John Jones was completely disembowelled with a knife in the hands of John Jones. After being so horribly cut, Jones was taken to a hospital in the head with a rock.
