**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS**  
**Murray State University**  
**October 29, 1999**  
**11:00 a.m.**

The Board of Regents of Murray State University met on October 29, 1999, in special session in the Jesse Stuart Room of the Pogue Library on the campus of Murray State University. The meeting was called to order by Chair Sid Easley at 11:00 a.m. Regent Jim Rudolph gave the invocation.

Upon roll call, the following members were present: Marilyn Buchanon, Olivia Burr, Lori Dial, Beverly Ford, Brandon Kirkham, Wells Lovett, Elizabeth McCoy, Michael Miller, Jim Rudolph, and Sid Easley. Absent: Tom Burich.

**Tuition Rates**

Mrs. Buchanon moved that the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of the President of the University, approve the attached tuition rates for the 2000-01 academic year and the 2001-02 academic year.

**Alumni Family Grant, increased**

Mr. Kirkham moved that the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of the President of the University, approve an increase in the Alumni Family Grant amount for new students from \$2,500 to \$2,750 per year effective with the academic 2000-01 year.

**Differentiation between Graduate and Undergraduate Tuition**

Mr. Kirkham moved that the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of the President of the University, rescind the action taken by the Board on September 17, 1999, which increased the differentiation between graduate and undergraduate tuition from a ratio of 1.1 to a ratio of 1.3 effective with the 2000-01 year.
