- The proposal must be submitted in APA 7 format, double-spaced with a maximum of 3-5 pages without including identification, abstract, or references in the page count- (Blind Peer Review)
 - Identification (separate from article)
 - Presenter Name with Highest degree
 - Presenters can be undergraduates, current teachers, and master or doctorate students or hold advanced degrees
 - Job Title and Employment Institution
 - Approving Institutional Review Boards (if applicable)
 - Title of Presentation or Article
 - Abstract of Presentation or Article (100-150 words)
 - Summary of Presentation
 - Brief Review of the Literature (1-3 paragraphs)
 - For original research: Methodology and Findings
 - **Implications for Practice**
